Drop-in Tour

The regular annual summer tour may have been cancelled, but we have found a way to still deliver a great field day to experience some of Manitoba's soils in the Elm Creek, Haywood and Bruxelles area.

There will be a special opportunity for 8 individuals to extract a full-scale soil monolith. This requires pre-booking a 1-hour time slot in advance and \$50 for all materials. Instructions on finishing your monolith will be provided virtually in the fall by MSSS.

This drop-in tour will allow outdoor physical distancing, and sanitation supplies will be provided (boot washing or plastic booties, wipes, handwashing).

We require that all participants self-screen prior to the event according to provincial COVID guidelines https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/

- Transportation: On your own.
- Lunch: On your own (bag lunches or Ma's Drive-In at Elm Creek).
- Washroom: porta-potty at Almasippi site, Ma's Drive Inn.
- Instructors will be on site from 9 am − 3 pm.
- Please register, but no charge for dropping in.
- \$50 for extracting full scale monolith (8 people only).
- Instruction and tools provided for profile description. Your description then contrasted with an "official" description.
- Discussions of appropriate soil management practices (drainage, fertility, residue management, erosion control, etc.) at all 3 sites.
- CCA credits (3.5 Soil and Water credits and 0.5 Nutrient Management credits available).
